Bulletin No. 10 (Window Cleaners)

To: Window Cleaning Members

We write to you on the subject of safety because of the number of accidents, which have occurred in the past year involving Window Cleaners who work in Union jobs, even though many of these accidents occurred while not working for Employers signatory to our Window Cleaners Agreement.

In some cases, accidents have involved faulty equipment and at others they have involved failure to follow safety procedures, which are recommended by the industry.

In an attempt to re-emphasize safety procedures, the Window Cleaners Training Fund will offer a course of instruction to refresh current Window Cleaners on basic safety procedures and acquaint employees with procedures to be followed on new equipment available in the industry. We suggest that you urge all of your current employees who are engaged in window cleaning to attend this refresher course in order to enhance safety procedures.

We also urge you to perform your own safety check on the equipment, which you use, including scaffolds and anchors.
